FUTURE MEETING PRESENTATIONS:

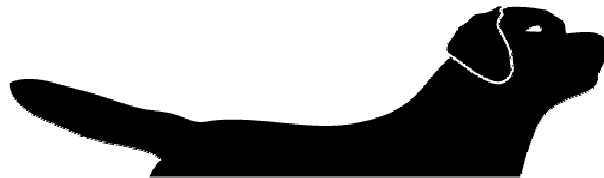
Dr. Al Stinson will give a talk in Sept.

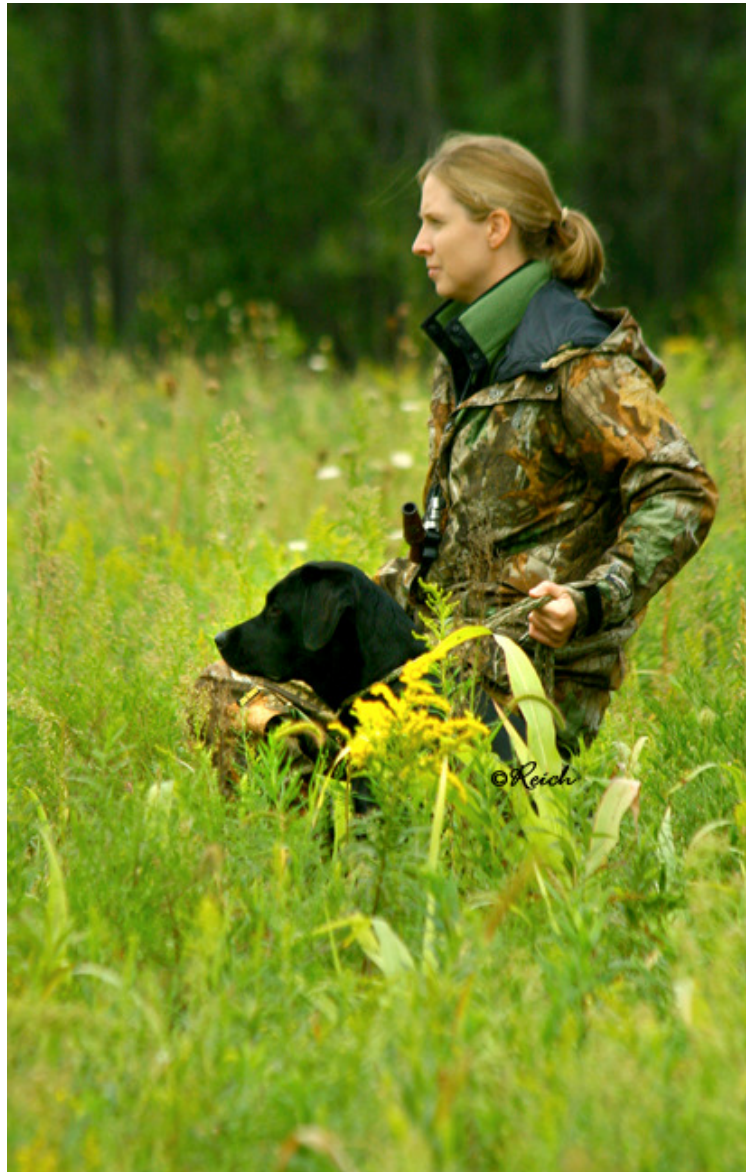
