AWARDS RECOGNITION:

The plaques will cost our club approximately \$60.43 plus engraving at \$.25 per letter, based on the purchase of 15 plaques at a time. The plaques will be given out yearly at our annual picnic. A form will be filled out by the qualifying owners to ensure proper spelling and titles received by their dogs. Additional titles already earned by qualifying dogs may be printed but will be at the owner's expense. Motion to approve the plaques was made and approved.

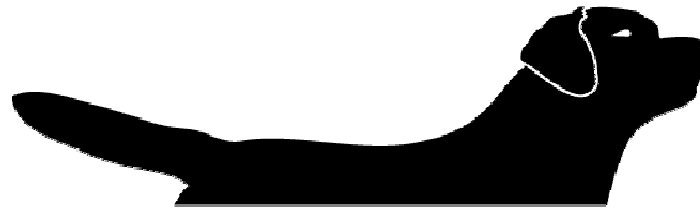
